

Falsifying information can result in punishment, fines, and tuition expenses: Any person who knowingly falsifies information on a form required for enrollment of a student in a school district commits a crime under Texas Penal Code Sec. 37.10. It is a

Class C Misdemeanor, punishable by a fine up to \$500. It is a third-degree felony if it is done with intent to defraud or harm another, punishable by a prison sentence of 2-10 years, plus a fine up to \$10,000. A person who falsifies enrollment information is also liable to the district for the maximum tuition fee the district may charge under Texas Education Code Section 25.03.
