



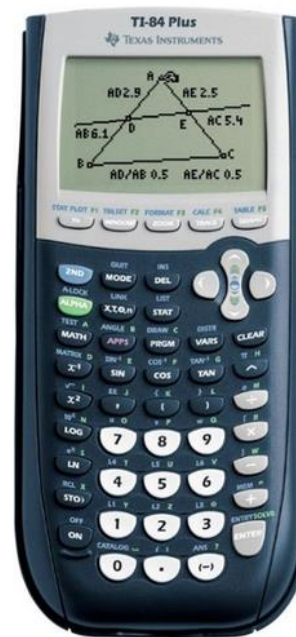
Allowable Calculators

Examinees may use any 4-function, scientific, or graphing calculator, as long as it is not on the prohibited list and it is modified, if needed. Examinees are encouraged to use a familiar calculator, but all problems may be solved without a calculator.
