

ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Uplift North Hills Preparatory is a tuition-free, public charter school managed by the Uplift Education charter school network. Located in the Dallas suburb of Irving, UNHP has been producing college-ready graduates for 21 years. At Uplift North Hills Preparatory, our vision is to create a positive school culture of respect and collaboration that prepares all students to succeed in college and become contributing global citizens. Uplift North Hills is an International Baccalaureate® Continuum school, authorized in Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma Programmes.

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Creativity, activity, service (CAS) is a key component of the IB Diploma Programme core. With its holistic approach, CAS is designed to strengthen and extend scholars' personal and interpersonal learning through experiences. CAS formally begins at the start of 11th grade and continues regularly for at least 18 months with a reasonable balance between creativity, activity and service. This often takes form in scholars participating in extra-curricular activities and community service in order to fulfill the requirements of CAS.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Uplift North Hills offers over 60 different extracurricular opportunities. These include organizations such as HOSA, Junior World Affairs Council, Model United Nations, DECA, in addition to the following UIL 4A Varsity athletic programs: Basketball (M/W), Cross Country (M/W), Track and Field (M/W), Tennis (M/W), Soccer (M/W), Golf (M/W), Volleyball (W), and Cheerleading (Co-Ed).

CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Rigor: Uplift North Hills is committed to exposing all scholars to a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. The International Baccalaureate was introduced to encourage students to be internationally minded and academically well-rounded. As an IB continuum school, North Hills is authorized to offer both the Middle Years Programme (MYP) for grades 6-10 and the Diploma Programme (DP) for grades 11-12. Uplift is a DP For ALL network and is committed to making sure that all scholars, regardless of their background or educational need, have access to participate in the Diploma Programme. Our scholars are also required to participate in the DP Core by taking the Theory of Knowledge course, completing the Creativity, Activity, and Service project, and writing the Extended Essay. Current seniors have also participated in AP and Dual Credit coursework.

Course Schedule: Uplift scholars accrue credits by semester, but most courses are year-long. Classes rotate on an A/B block schedule with five days of four 90-minute periods. The schedule also includes RISE Time (Advisory), lunch, and enrichment/intervention.

Graduation Requirements: Scholars must attempt the full Foundation High School Program, at least one Endorsement and the Distinguished Level of Achievement (26+ credits). Any scholar graduating on the Foundation Only program (22 credits) requires additional approval. Scholars must complete the following:

- Honors/Pre-AP/Dual Credit courses receive an extra 0.5 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- AP/DP courses receive an extra 1.0 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- Credit recovery is mandatory for all failed courses required for graduation, all attempts are included on the transcript and calculated into the GPA.
- Pass/Fail, Local Credit, HS credit earned in Middle School, and courses for which the scholar received prior credit, are not included in the GPA.
- · It is Uplift Education's policy not to rank scholars.
- Uplift Education uses a criterion-based approach to grading. All major grades are meant to reflect
 the scholar's skills and knowledge using a variety of summative and formative assessment tools.
 Classroom grading procedures are directly related to clear criteria and standards that show evidence
 of scholar mastery. Grades for behaviors such as effort and participation are considered minor
 grades and are either not calculated in the overall grade or calculated as a small percentage, no
 more than 20%.

ADVANCED COURSES

- All courses in grades 6-10 are taught as part of the IB Middle Years Programme unless otherwise noted.
- All scholars in grades 11-12 are required to participate in some component of the IB Diploma Programme.


